



## Alameda City 2020 Campaign Contributions

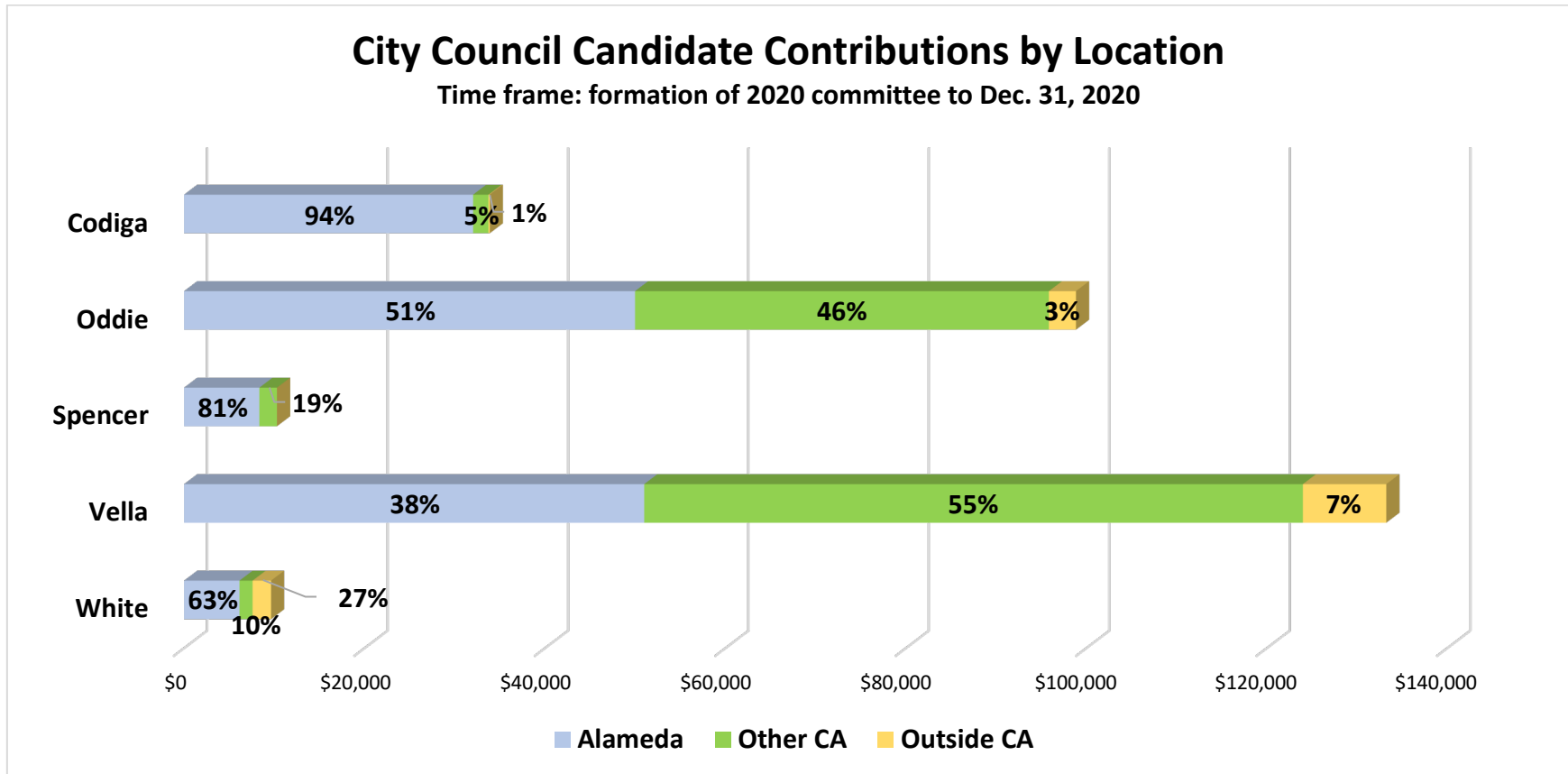
*November 3, 2020 election*

### **Understanding the Charts**

- The charts cover all contributions made to candidates from the time they created campaign finance committees for the November 2020 election, whether or not they have filed for office. These start dates will vary by candidates. The two City Council incumbents formed their 2020 committees and started raising money soon after their prior elections.
- Charts cover all candidates who filed for election, whether or not they have filed the required California Form 460 campaign contribution reports. Where candidates have not filed Form 460, a notation has been made on the chart.
- The totals reflect all contributions reported on California Form 460 for the November 3, 2020 election between the time the committee was formed and December 31, 2020 as posted on the [City of Alameda website](#).
- The data reflect both monetary and non-monetary contributions in excess of \$100 from any one source. Contributions of less than \$100 are not itemized by source in Form 460 and are therefore reflected only in the Contributions by Size charts and not in the Location and Type charts.
- The total contributions to individual candidates do not reflect amounts spent on their behalf by General Purpose Committees. If the candidates are not coordinating this support, they are not required to include it as a financial contribution to their campaign.
- Categories of information in the charts (type of contributor, location of contributor and size of donation) are the same categories used to record the information in the 460s; we have labeled the categories somewhat differently for clarity. Contributions from special purpose PACs connected to unions or businesses have been categorized as union or business based on the source; contributions from general purpose PACs are listed as political.
- Location is determined by the mailing address listed for the contributor in the filing forms. If the contribution came from a group, the address of the group rather than its individual members determines how the contribution is categorized by location.

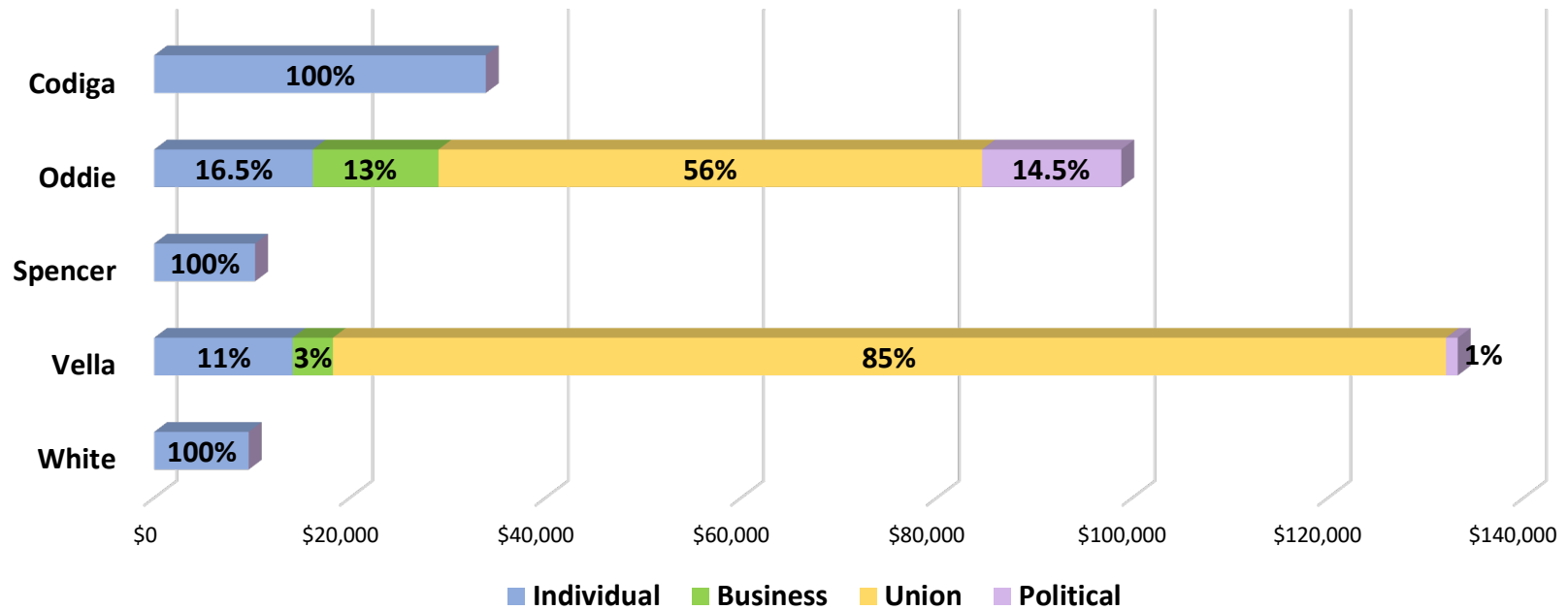

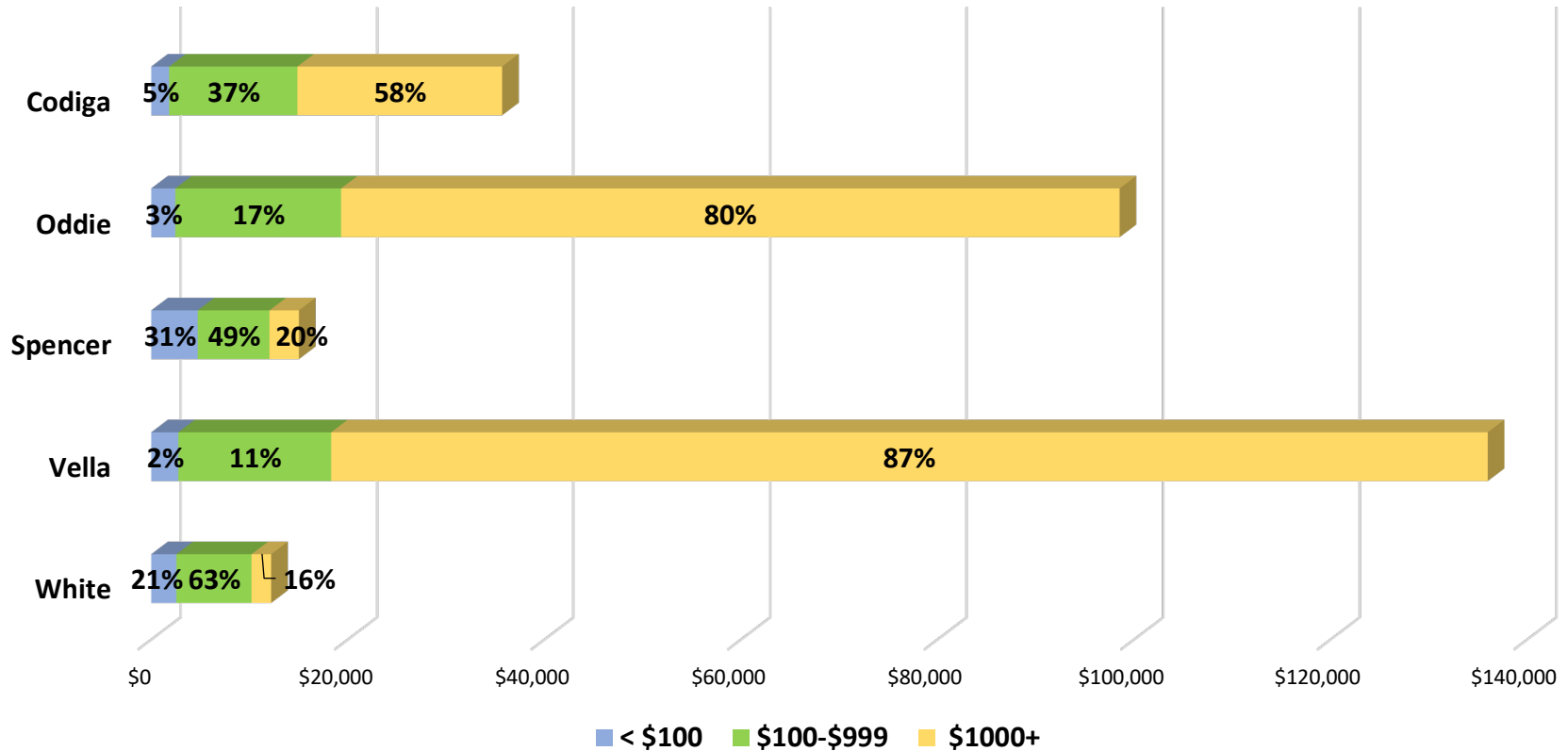

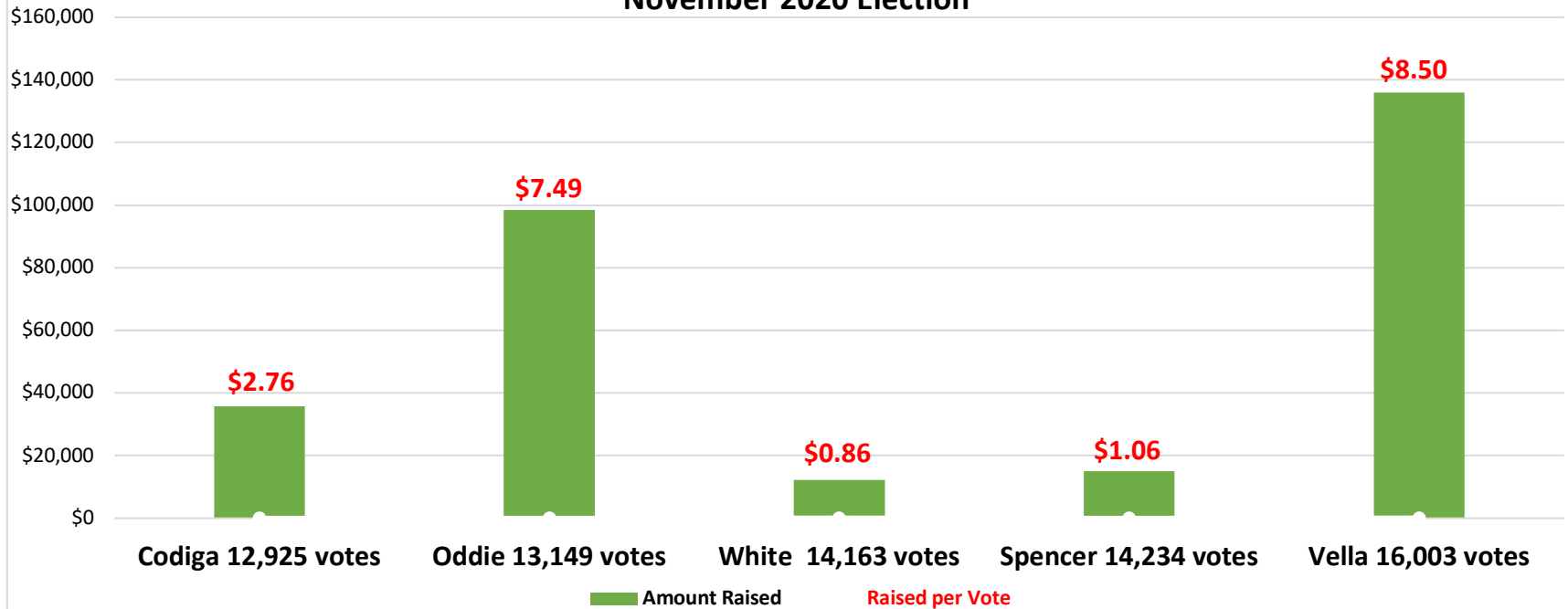

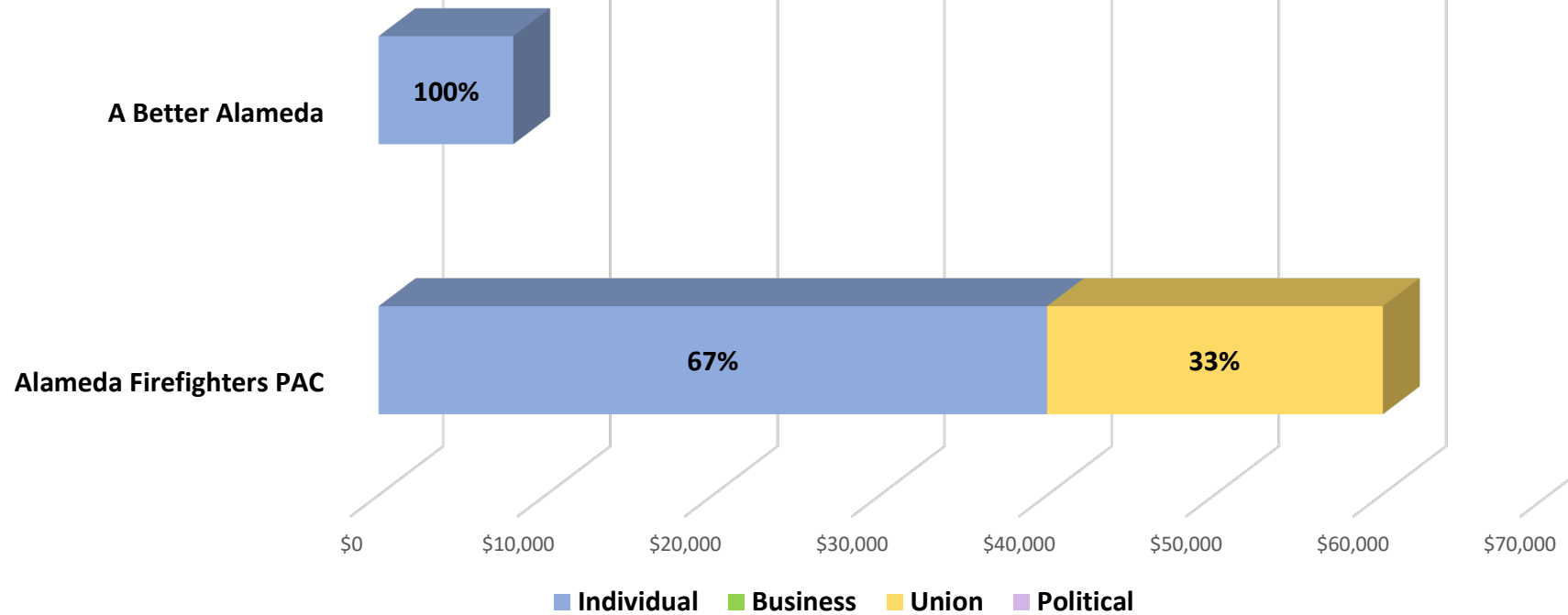

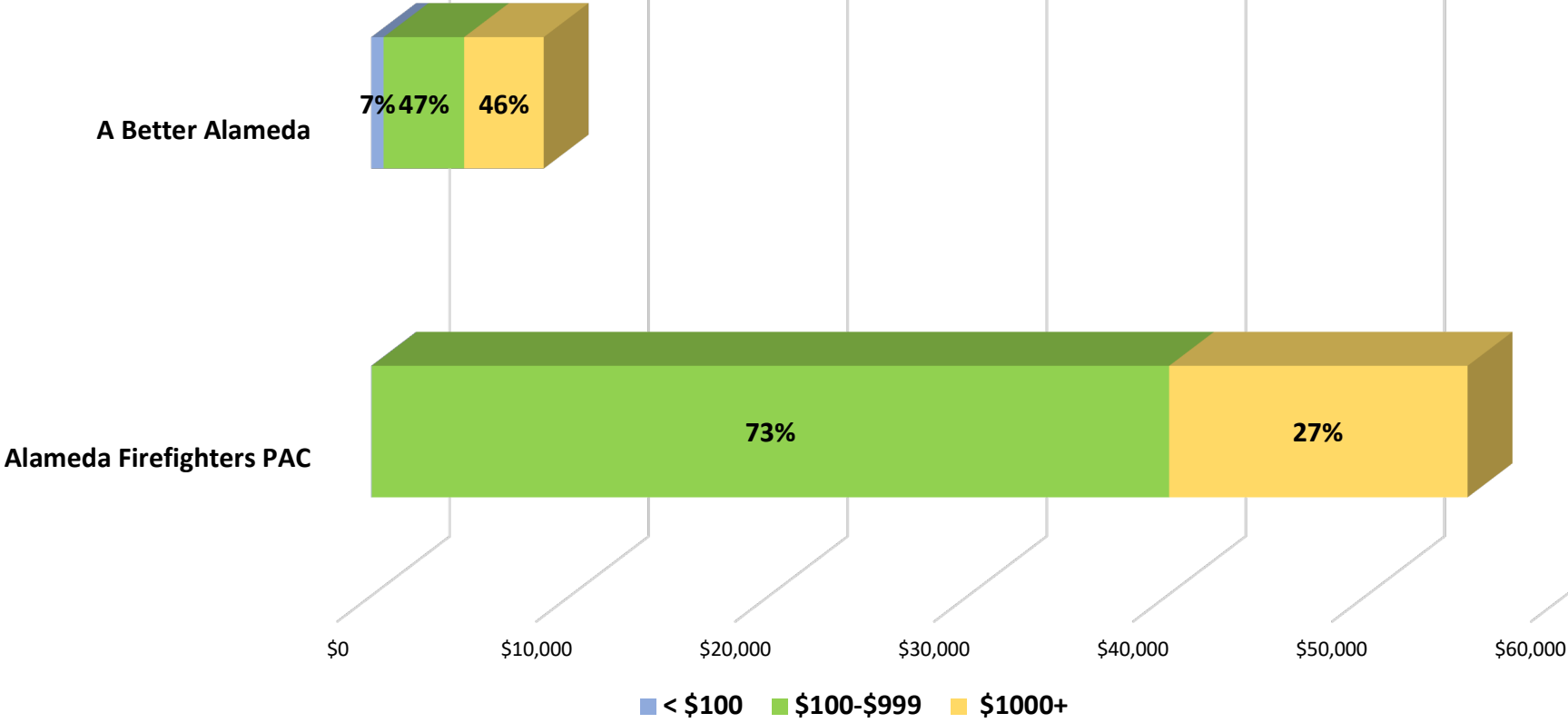

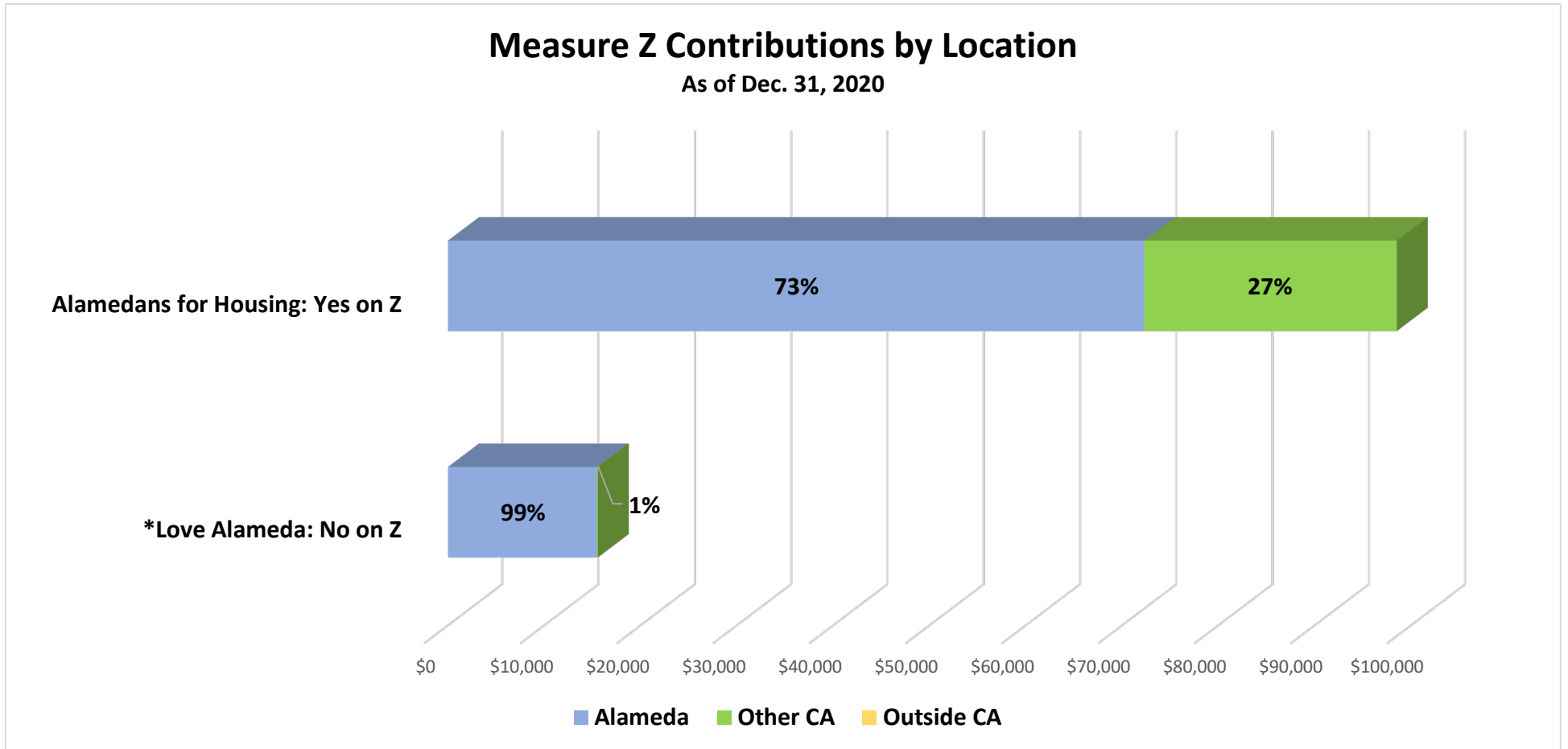

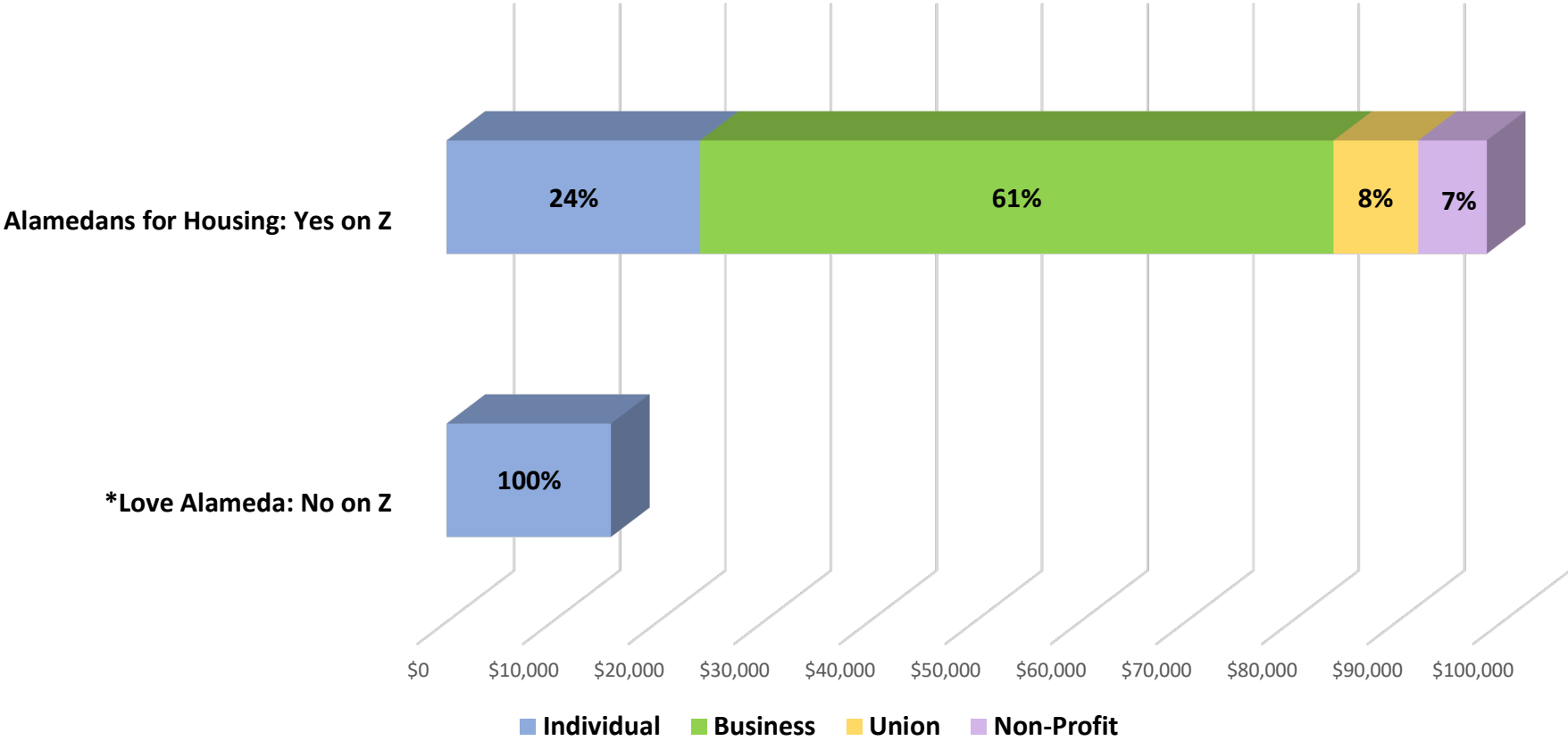

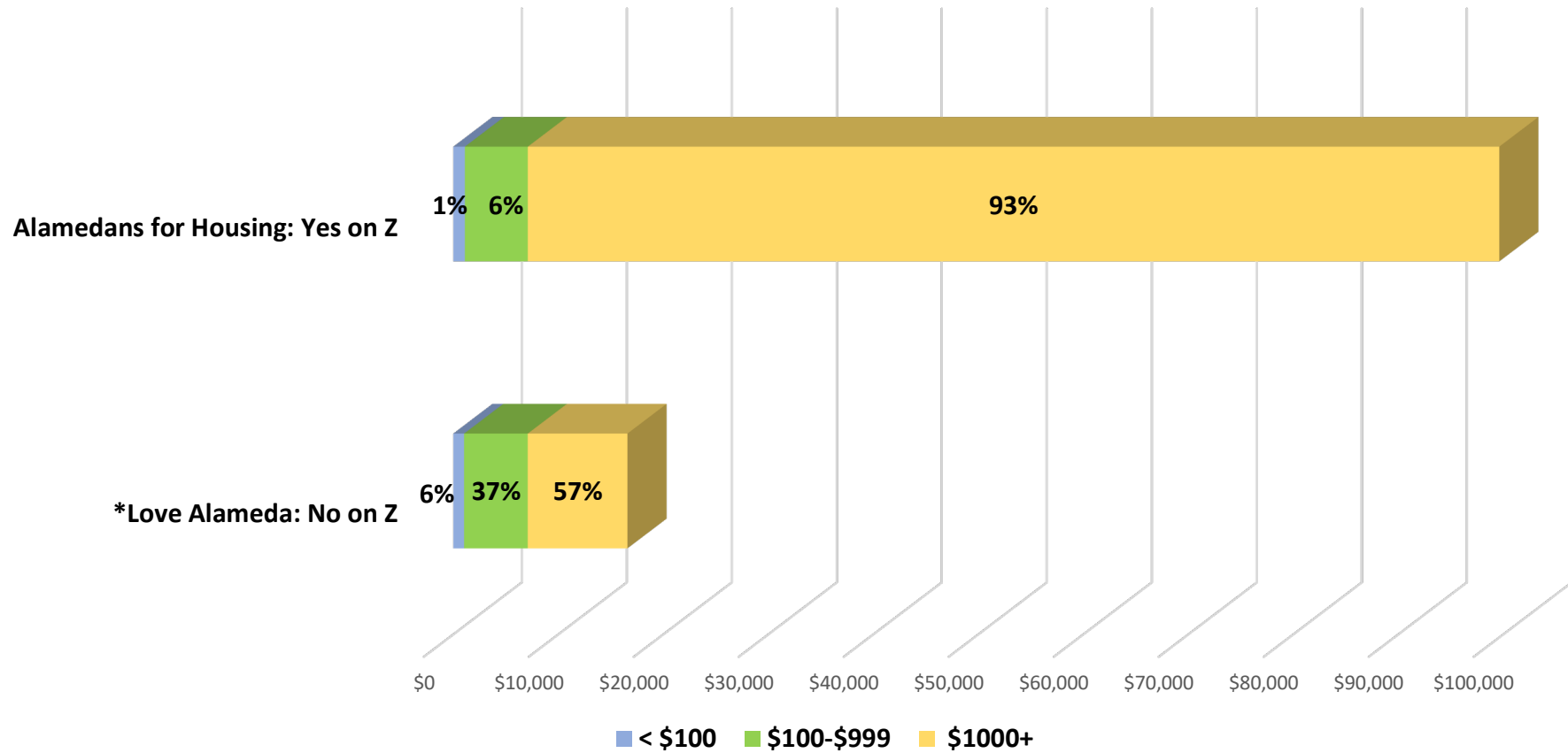

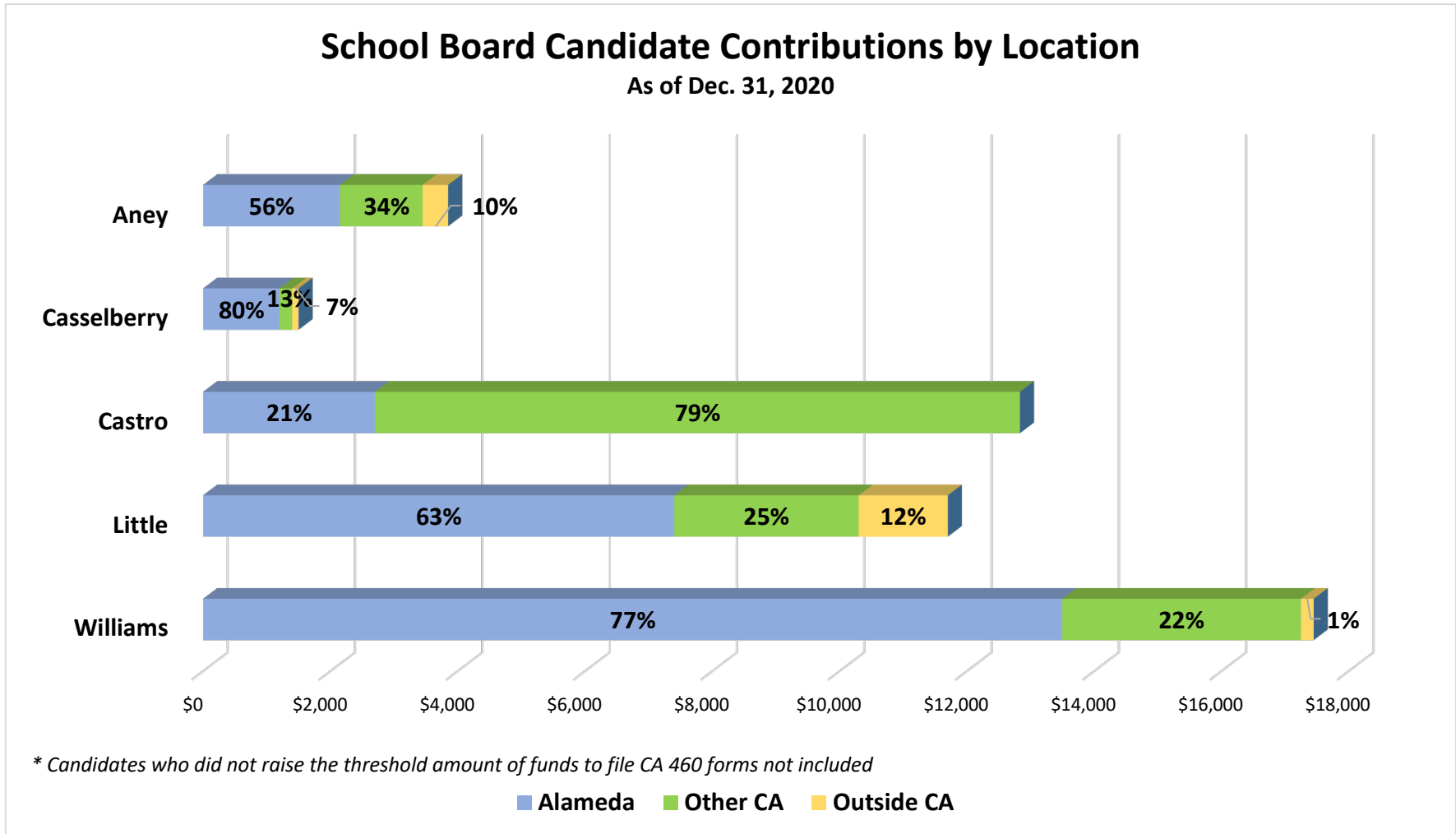

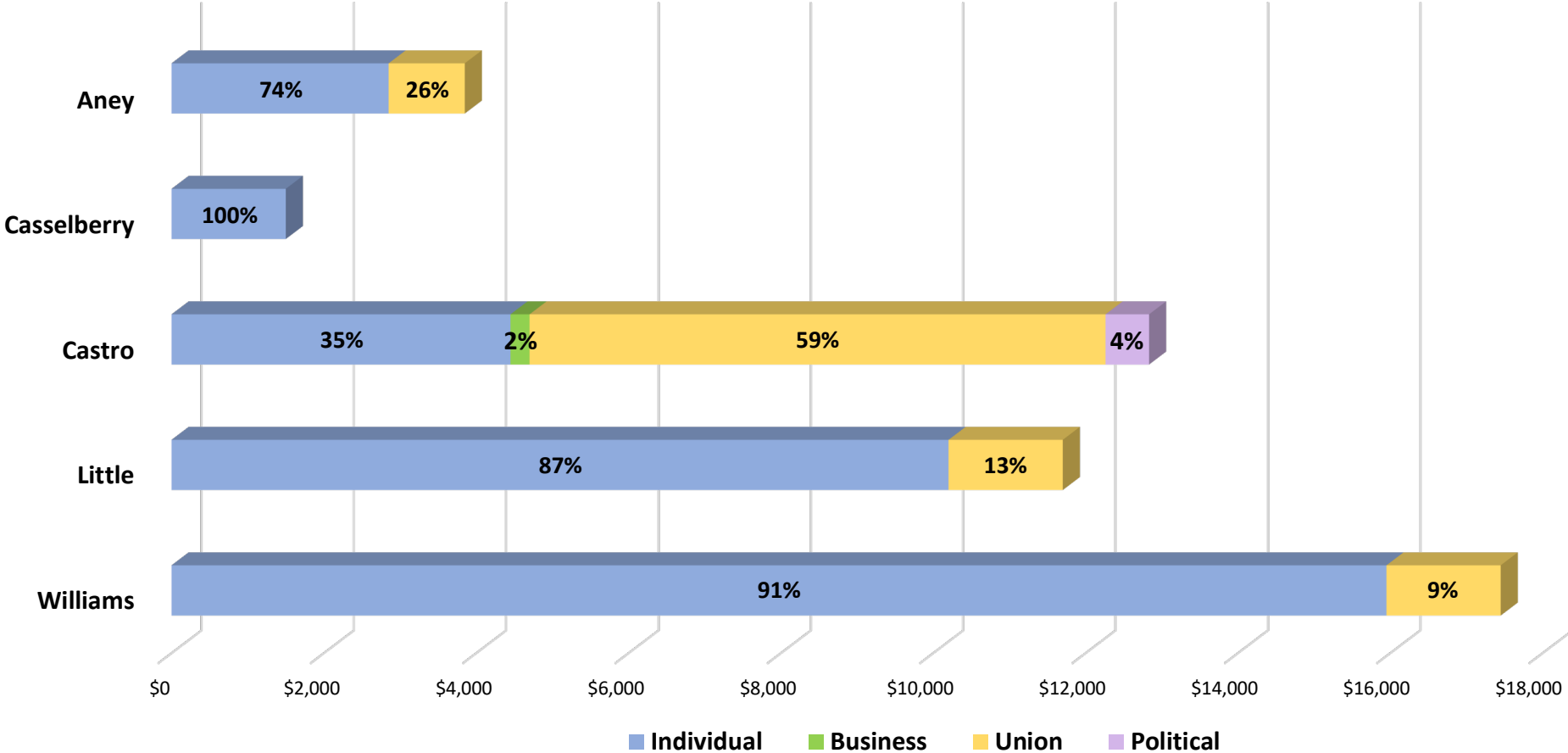

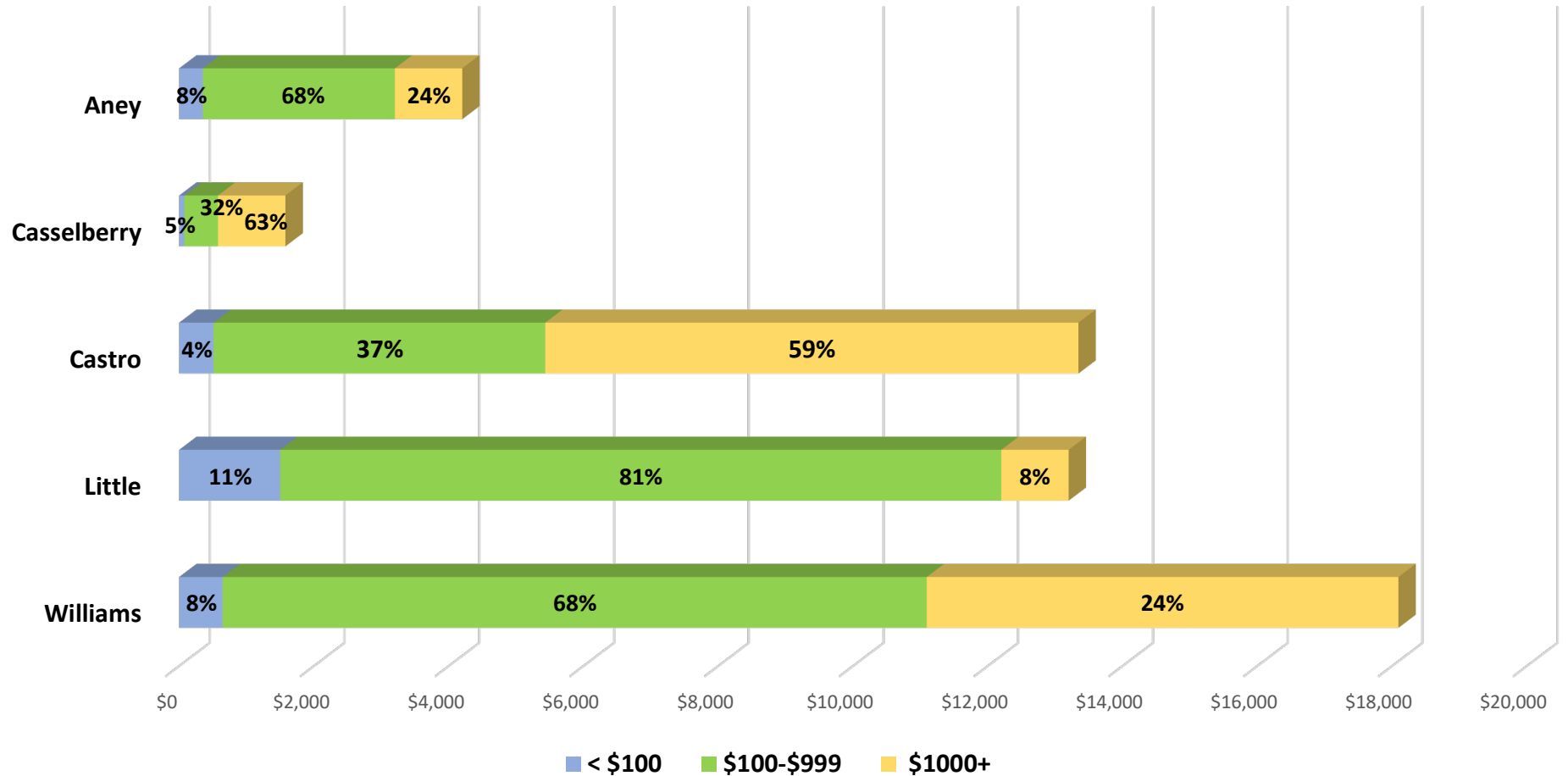
