A few reminders. Voting has changed during the pandemic but it is still easy and safe to vote. Every registered voter in California will receive a ballot in the mail. You can also still vote in person. Follow these three tips to make sure your ballot is counted:

1. **Sign** your ballot envelope before returning it.
2. **Vote early** - you can mail your ballot or return it at a Dropbox or other voting location. You may also be able to [vote early in person](#).
3. **Track your ballot** - [WheresMyBallot](#) also allows you to check the status of your ballot after you return it.
