Centennial celebration: Help organize events in 2020 for the League's centennial year and anniversary of the 19th amendment: films, poster contest, speakers, Fourth of July parade. **Sheila**

Political action: Work on governmental transparency and campaign finance in Alameda; write pros & cons and positions on local issues. Monitor City Council meetings, follow legislation. **Karen**

Programs: Help plan LWVA's community forums (several each year) on key national, state and local public policy issues. Propose topics and arrange for speakers; work on publicity. **William**

Voter service: In election years, solicit candidates' data for *SmartVoter.org*; study local ballot measures and LWVA positions; contact candidates and present ballot pros and cons at League forums; distribute *Easy Voter Guide*; register voters and help get out the vote. **Ken, Barbara**

Communications: Help produce LWVA's online newsletter *The Voter*; work with a team on twice-monthly e-blasts, Website and Facebook; help produce press releases, flyers, display ads. **Keasha**

Membership: Recruit and orient new members; match members' interests with volunteer opportunities. Reach out to community groups with information about LWVA. **Doris**

Money management: Work with the LWVA budget, collect dues, pay bills and manage our treasury. Bookkeeping/accounting experience desirable. **Adina, Anna**

Inter-League Liaison: Connect with other Bay Area Leagues by attending joint meetings and events; attend state or national conventions. Let us all know what's going on. **Sally, Kate**

Social events and Book Club: Help organize First Friday dinners in local restaurants and other get-togethers such as wine tasting, social mixers, film showings. **Anne McKereghan** Participate in LWVA's monthly Book Club on Fourth Mondays; suggest new books ideas; engage! **Felice**
